Guidelines to Authors

Aim and Scope: The journal will consider original papers for publication on all aspects of various subjects from all the faculties.

Types of contributions: Original research article, Review articles, Short and preliminary communications, Book reviews, Research news

Submission of papers: Authors are invited to submit manuscripts (One hard copy and 1.4 MB floppy MS word, RTF) or in electronic form (separate files for text, tables, and Figs in jpeg format) via e-mail to the:

Contributions are accepted on the understanding that the authors have not published or communicated this mss elsewhere and the findings are original.

Manuscript: Manuscript should be in double space on pages of uniform size (A-4) with a defined margin (left 1.5", right 1", top and bottom 1"). Each table should be typed on separate page. All tables and illustrations should bear a title or legend. Tables of numerical data should be in clear type, suitable, if found necessary for photographic reduction and scanning without loss of clarity.

An abstract of 50-200 words should be included at the beginning of the paper. No abstract would be needed for "short communication".

References: The references should be arranged alphabetically and listed at the end of manuscript, in the following way:

Illustrations: One set of the **original drawing** is required together with duplicate sets. Legends to illustration should be typed in sequence on a separate page or pages.

Proof of mss: Manuscripts should bear the name and address of the person to whom the galley proof is to be sent. The author will receive proof of the paper before printing, and corrected proof should be returned to the Editorial office within 72 hrs.
