 - 3) **Absorption of examinee after exhausting of additional chances for B.P.E./ B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed. courses**
 - 4) **Scheme of Equivalence and absorption of old courses Annual Pattern to New Courses Examinations (B.P.E., B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed.) i.e. Semester Pattern.**

It is notified for general information of all concerned, that the authorities of the University has taken following decision for admission of old courses /failure students of annual pattern to new course examination of Semester Pattern for B.P.E., B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed. to be implementation from the academic session 2014-2015.

It is further notified that the authorities of the University has accepted the scheme of equivalence and absorption of old course (Failure Students) Annual Pattern to New Course (Semester Pattern) examination of B.P.E., B.P.Ed & M.P.Ed. to be implemented from the academic session 2014-15. The students passed in old course (Annual Pattern) shall be admitted in new course semester-pattern as per scheme of equivalence and absorption accordingly.

The schemes of equivalence & absorption of B.P.E., B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed. courses shall be Appended as per Appendices -“A”, “B” & “C” appended respectively with this Notification.

1] ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN M.P.ED. (SEMESTER PATTERN) FROM B.P.ED. OLD &/ NEW COURSE.

- a) Student/s completing their B.P.Ed. (One Year) in full from the earlier scheme i.e.80: 20 (having six papers) and part II & part III shall consider as eligible candidate to admit in new programme of M.P.Ed. (Semester Pattern)
- b) The scheme shall be enforced till summer-2016 Examination only.

2) ABSORPTION SCHEME FOR ADMISSION IN B.P.E. SEMESTER III & IV AND V &VI OF NEW COURSE TO STUDENTS OF B.P.E.1ST AND IInd YEAR (ANNUAL PATTERN) RESPECTIVELY

- a) Student/s completing First B.P.E.(Annual Pattern) in full course from the earlier scheme i.e. having six papers (80:20) and part II shall absorb to admit in the new programme of B.P.E. for Second year (i.e. semester IIIrd & IVth) in their respective College/ Institute.
- b) Student/s completing both First Year B.P.E. of Annual Pattern i.e. having six papers (80:20) & part II; and second year B.P.E. of Annual Pattern i.e. having five papers (80:20) and part II & Part III in full form th earlier scheme shall absorb to admit in the new programme of B. P.E. for Third year (i.e. semester Vth & VIth) in their respective College/ Institute.
- c) The scheme shall be enforced till summer -2016 Examination only.

3) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN NEW POST GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMME OF M.P.Ed. (4 SEMESTER PATTERN)/ B.P.ED. 1 YEAR (NEW POST DEGREE PROGRAMME) FROM OLD COURSE OF B.P.E.3 YEAR (ANNUAL PATTERN) PROGRAMME

3 years degree programme of old B.P.E. course (Annual Pattern) shall be considered as equivalent programme of 3 year degree B.P.E. (New Courses-Semester Pattern) and thereby shall consider the eligible course to new programme of M.P.Ed. course (2 years-4 Semester Pattern) B.P.Ed. 1 Year (Post Degree Programme) of New Course.

4) ABSORPTION SCHEME FOR ADMISSION IN M.P.ED. IIIrd & IVth (NEW SEMESTER COURSE) FROM OLD COURSE M.P.ED. 1ST YEAR (ANNUAL PATTERN)

The absorption scheme for admission in new course of M.P.Ed. IIIrd & IVth Semester to the student/s passed M.P.Ed. 1st Year (Yearly Pattern) as follows.

- a) Student/s completing M.P.Ed. 1st Year (Annual Pattern) in full course from the earlier scheme i.e. having six papers (80-20) shall be considered as eligible candidate to admit in the new Programme M.P.Ed. (Semester IIIrd & IVth).
- b) The Scheme shall be enforced till summer-2016 Examination only.

5) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION IN RELEVANT COURSE OF HIGHER STUDENTS.

Student/s completing M.P.Ed. (Old pattern Course/& Half of New Pattern) successfully in full course, shall consider as eligible candidate/s for further relevant students of higher education.

6) Eligibility for admission in new Post Graduate Programme of M.P.Ed. (4 Semester Pattern) B.P.Ed. 1st year (New Post Degree Programme) from old course of B.P.E. 3 year (Annual Pattern) programme.

3 years degree programme of Old B.P.E. course (Annual pattern) shall be considered as equivalent programme of 3 year degree B.P.E. (new course- semester pattern) and thereby shall consider the eligible course to new programme of M.P.Ed. course (2 years-4 Semester pattern)/ B.P.Ed. I Year (post degree programme) of new Course.

7) The scheme of equivalence and absorption, the students of 1st & IInd B.P.E. passed in old course are to be allowed to admit accordingly in new semester pattern i.e. IIIrd & IVth and Vth & VIth and thereon they are to be allowed to appear the respective examination simultaneously.

- a) Failure student/s of B.P.E. IInd Year (earlier scheme) in the relevant subjects (Part-I) and Part-II Skill Examination shall have to opt new proposed subjects (given in above table as Appendix-A with sr.No.8 to 13 respectively) in column 6 against column 4)
- b) Marks obtained by the examinees in the Equivalent/ & Absorbed Scheme be proportionately converted into the marks in the old scheme of examination.
- c) Student/s completing their B.P.E. IInd year successfully in full course from Old Scheme shall absorb as illegible candidate/s to admit in their respective College/Institute for B.P.E. Sem.V & VI. Such admitted students shall be considered as the students of new course.
- d) Said Equivalence/& Absorption scheme shall be valid till the subject/papers mentioned as above table (Appendix-A) at column No.6 in the existing scheme of examination are in force.

3) Revised /Modified Scheme of Equivalence/& Absorption to failure student/s of B.P.E. IIIInd (old Annual Pattern)

- a) Failure student/s of B.P.E. 3rd Year (earlier scheme) in the relevant subjects (Part-I), Part-II Skill & Part-III (Teaching Ability) Examination shall have to opt the new proposed subjects (given in above table as Appendix-A with sr.No.14 to 20 respectively) in column 6 against column 4) .
- b) Marks obtained by the examinees in the Equivalent/ & Absorbed Scheme be proportionately converted into the marks in the old scheme of examination.
- c) Said Equivalence/& Absorption scheme shall be valid till the subjects/papers mentioned as above table (Appendix-A) at column No.6 in the existing scheme of examination are in force.

4) ABSORPTION SCHEME FOR ADMISSION IN B.P.E. SEMESTER III & IV AND V & VI OF NEW COURSE TO STUDENTS OF B.P.E. 1st & IInd YEAR (ANNUAL PATTERN) RESPECTIVELY

- a) Student/s completing First B.P.E. (Annual Pattern) in full course from the earlier scheme i.e. having six papers (80:20) and Part-II shall absorb to admit in the new Programme of B.P.E. for Second year (i.e.semester IIIrd & IVth) in their respective College/Institute.
- b) Student/s completing both First Year B.P.E. of Annual Pattern i.e. having six papers (80:20) & Part-II; and second year B.P.E. of Annual Pattern i.e. having five papers (80:20) and Part-II & Part-III in full from the earlier scheme shall absorb to admit in the new Programme of B.P.E. for Third year (i.e. semester Vth & VIth) in their respective College/Institute.
- c) The scheme shall be enforced till summer-2016 Examination only.

 - e) Statement of Marks for Final Mark-Sheet shall be prepared accordingly (with due conversion)
 - f) Equivalence / & Absorption scheme shall be valid till the subject/papers mentioned as above table (Appendix-C) at column No.6 existing scheme of examination are in force.
