No. VI of 2017), the Government ut Maharashtma beroby, 1 bscribes the uniform Statiato rolating to procedure for conduct of Elections to variout authoritse and bodies of the university, mamoly :-

## UNTFORM STATUTE No. 1 OF 2017.

1. Short litle. This Statute may be called the Maharashtra Public Universitics (Proceciac for Concioct of Flections to Various Authorities and Bodies of the University) Uniform Shatite, 2017.
2. Sefinitions.-(1) In these Statutes, mass the context otherwise requires,-
(i) "Act" means the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. VI of 2017);
(b) "cicar days" means all days in a schedule with exclusion of both the first and the lasi day ( $6 . g$. from Monday to Monday, there are six clear days);
(c) "continuing candidate" means any candiciate not ciected or not excluded from the
poll at any given stage of counting of votes;
(d) "Count" means ail the operations involved in the counting of the first proferences reconded for candidates; or all the operations invoived in the transfer of the surplus of an elected candidate; or all the operations invoived in the transfer of the votes of an oliminated candidate or of two or more candidates oliminated together;
(e) "eiector" means any person entiticd to vote in the dection of any authority or bodiy of the University;
(/) "first preference" means the digit" " standing alone opposite the name of a candidate; "socond proference" means the digit" " 2 " standing alone opposite the name of the candidate in succession to the digit " 1 "; "third preference" means the digit " 3 " standing alone opposibe the rame of a candidate in succession to the digits " 1 " and " 2 " and so on, on the voting paper
(f) "next availabie preforence" means a second or subsequent preference recorded in consentive numerical order for a contizuing candidate, the preferences, zext in order on voting paper for candidates already elected or eliminated from the poll being ignored;
(h.) "non-transferable paper" moans a voting paper on wifich no second or subsequent preference is recorcied for a continuing candidate or the names of two or more candidater (whet er continuing or not) are marked with the same number and are next in order of predenece; or the name of the candidate next in order of preforence (whether continuing or twh is marked by a mumber not following consecutively aftor some other number on the: voligg paper; or by two or more numbers or for any other reason it cannot de determinot for which of the continuing candidates nex available preference of the elector is reconcied;
(i) "original vote" in regard to any candiate means a vote derived from a voting pape: on vorch a first preference is recorded for that candidate;
(i) "quota" means the number of votes sufficient to secure the election of a candidate, delonemed at each election by dividing the total number of valid votes cast at an election by the number of vacancies to be filled plus one at that election and by adding, one bo he resilt so arrived at, any fractional remainder in doing so shall be disregarded;

(1) Each ciector shall have one transferable vote

(f) in an clection by ballot any mark is placed by the voter by which he may afterwards ue idensified; or
(g) preference is indicated in any ink other than blue ink;
(h) there is any seratching, overwriting or alteration in the digits indicating the voler's preforence.
(2) A valid ballot paper with moxt preference given to more tian one candidate shall become invalid for such immediatoly subsequent proferenco.
if Iowers of the Registrar to Prepare Sohedule of Election, Validity of Votes and Resull. of Elections.--

The Registrar shall have the power,-
(1) to prepare the Scbeciule of alections and get the same approved by the Vice Charicellor;
(2) to decide, in case of doubt, the validity or invaidity of a vote recorded;
(3) to declare the result of each election.
8. Electoral Roll.-
(1) The Registrar shall prepare soparate electoral roll for collogiums entitled to vote, whit the names in alphabetical order beginning with surname-first name-midide name and adtuasses.
(2) Fxcept when are election is hed at a meoting, the persons entitled to vote at an dotion to any of the authorities or bodies shall, respectively, bee the persons whose naraes ane entered on their respective alectoral roll.
(3) The provisional electoral roi of persons, efititled to vote at an election to the authonties or bodies of the Uriversity shall be published on the Election Portai on the official web site of the University, al least forty-five clear days before the date of cioction.
(1) The Registrar shall have the power to correct the electoral roll, if any omission or wronf entries are brought to his notice within five days from the date of publication of the

(7) In the case of dispute of dount regarding the validity of a nomination paper, an apenl may be made to the Vico-Chance:lor and his decision shall be final.
(8) If the number of valid nominations does not exceed the number of vacancies to be fillot, the candidates nominated shall be declared to have been elected on the date ol cienalation of rosult of clection.
11 Procedure for election by Ballol ai a Meeling.-
(1) In the agerna for the meeting of an anthomity on body, an item of election by bailen shal be included and the duration for voting, shail bo precisely notified.
(2) Voting papers with the names of persons mominated, printed or typed thereon st. ti je furnished at the meeting held for the purpose of the clection. All the eligible memers present at the meeting shall be entitled to vote at the election. When two oi Ens asthorities or bodies are jointly entitled to elect a representative ard the clection bates place at a mecting, a member who is common to two or more authorities or bodies: shat be entitled to unly one vote. The sorutiny shall bo conductec by the Registrar or the perion nominated by him ard not less than two serutinizers to be selected by the Chairperson O. Wic mecting from amongst those present at the mecting.

12 Procedure for Mlection at Polting Centres...-
In all cases when an olection is held wherein votes are to be recorded at pollings wentos, the procedure for the recording of votes by ballot shall be as under:-
(1) The polling oentres shall be deeded by the Regisirar. The Registrar shatl appoint as many Polling, Officers as are necessary at the polling centres.
(2) The hours of voting at the respective polling contres shall be determand in advance and stated in tize notice af ciection.
(3) It shall be responsibility of tho Principals of affilated or conducted colleges and Hoads of the recognized institutions to provide all necessary infrastructure, support lacilities and man power for the smooth and timely conduct of elections.
(4) Names of contusting candidates shall be notified to voters within three days wfter the last date of withdrawal of nominations.
(5) The Poling Oificer shati ensure that the law and order is maintained at the polling contre. No persun other than a voter shall be permitted to enter ine poling rompariment.
(6) No voter shall bo allowed to enter the polling compartment for recording his wote before the commencement or afice the expiry of the period fixed for the purpose.
(7) Immediateiy bofore the polling commences, the Polling Officer shall show lo 1.te eandidate or his anthorized agents present at tho Poling Contre that the bailod loox is coupty and shail then lock and seal it for the use.
(8) Immediately before the ballot paper is issued to a voter, the number of the voter shall be entered on the counterfoil, and the same shall be signed by the voter and a mark shall be paced by the issuing officer in his copy of the electoral roll against the rumber of the voter to whom the voting paper is issued.
(9) Before the baliot paper is issued to a voter, a mark of indelible ink shall bo nade on the forefinger of the right hand of the voter. In the case where the voler has his forefinger missing, a mark of indelible ink shatl be made on any other finger of his ight hand, and in the case where al: the fingers of his right hand are missing, a maris of indelible ink shal be rade on the forefinger or any other finger of his left hand, and in tho case where ah his fingers of both the haide are missing, a mark of indelibir: ak shall be made on his right or lelt arm as he poesesses.
(10) The voter on receiving the ballot paper shall forthwith proceed to one of the - polling comorarments, whore be shat mark his preference/s and pui his paper into the bellot box.
(1L) If the poilines offere is sutisfied inat owing to bindness ow oher physical infirmity, a voter is undible to make a wark on the batot papor whthout assistance, ho shall permit the voter bo tace with him a companion ai not less man oightoon years of age to the polling compartmont for recording the wote on the ballot paper on bis behaif and in docordanor with ho wishos, ard, ir necessary, for folding ho bahot papor so as to conceal the whe are insomting it into the baíot box:

Provided that, ro powson what in permitted to aci as the comyanion of mome ihan one voter at any polling ontre on wo same day:

Provided further has, before any person is pomiteod to ant as tho comparion of a veter on ary day, he shail be required to deciare that he whateep secret he voto recorded by kim on behalf ot the voter and that ho has not already acted as the companion of axy other voter at, ary polling oentre on that day, The poling offore

No persor other than the candidate or his authorized agent and the ?er on involved in election process shall be ahowed within a radius of reasonable distance fron the piace of counting
(4) If at the ead of any count, the number of votes credited to a candidate is cqual wo or sreater than the quota, the candidate shall thereupon be declared as elected.
(5) If at the end of any count, the number of votes credited to a candiate is greater ihas the quota, the surplus shall be sransferred, as provided in this statute, to the continumg cmitidates for whom the next availabio preferences liave been recorded on tho votines papars in the parcel or sub-parcel last received by the ciecied candidate.
(6) If more than one candidate has surplus, the largest surplus shall be first dealt with. If swo or more candidates have equal surplus, the surplus of the candidate with the groatest number of votes at the first count at which the candidates in question have an unequal number of votes shall be first deait with. When the number of votes credited io: such candidates is equal at all courats, the Registrar shall determine by lot which surphes lue will first deal with.
(7) The Registrar or the person or persons authorized by him, shall not transfor a surglus when that surpius, hogethor with any other surplus not transferred, is less that: the difference-..
(a) between the votes of the candidates lowest on the poll and the votes of the: next highest candidate or
(b) betweon the total of the votes of the two or more candidates lowest on the pois and the voles of the next highest candidate:

Proviced that, the exchusion from the poll of the aforesaid two or more candidatos lowest on the poll shal! not reduce the number of continuing candidates below the number of vacancies remaining to be filled.
(8) (a) If the votes credited to an elected candidate consist of original votes only, the Registrar or the person or persons authorized by him, shall examine all the papers contained in the parcel of the elected candidate whose surphus is to be transferred.
(b) If the votes crecited to an clected candidate consist of original and transferrat voles, or transferred votes only, ihe Registrar or the person or persons authorized by him, shall examine the papers contained in the sub-parcel last received by the elected candidate whose surplus is to be transferred.
(c) In either case, the Registrar or the person or persons authorized by him, shall sort. the transferable papers into stib-parcels according to the next available preference recorded houcon, shall make a soparate sub-parcel of the non-transferabie papers and shail ascertain the number of papers in each suk-parcel of transferable papers.
(9) If the total number of papers in the sub-parcels of transferable papers is equal to or less than the surplus, the Registrar or the person or persons authorized by him, shall wayser the whole of each sub-parel of transferable papers to the continuing candidates as yer the next available proferences indicated thereon and shall set aside as a separate yavel so many of the nontransferable papers as are not required for the quota of the cluceed candidate. The particular papers set aside shall be those last filed in the parcel of won transferable papers.
(10) If the total number of iransferable papers is greater than the surplus, the Regstraror the person or persons authorized by him, shal: transfer from each sub-parco of tansferabie papers to the continuing candidate indicated thereon as the elector's next avatiable proference, the number of papers which bears the same proportion to the numbes of fapers in the stib-parcols as the surpius bears to the total number of transferable mopers.

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(11) The number of pafexs to be transferred from each sub-parcel shali be ascortainod b. rultiplying the number of papers in tho atoparol by the surplus and dividing the ranit by the total number of valid transerable papers.

A note shall be made of the fractional part, if any, of each number a ascertained. if ontag to the existerce of such fracional paris, the number of papers to be transferred is de: han the surplus, so many of these fractiona! parts taicen in the order of their magritude. beroning with the largest, as aro necessary to make the wial number of papers to be Wm:ferred equal to the surplus shat be rockoned as of the valuo of unity and remaining, finconal parts shall be iscored. (13) If at the end of any count, no candidate has a aurplas or i" any existing surplus ned not be and is not uransferred and one or more vacancios remain to be filied, tho Registrar shall exclude rom the por the candiate lowast on the poll.
(14) If the total of the votes of the two or more candidatos wowest on the poll, together whth any surplus not irenserred, is lese than the rumber of votes credited to the nex. Relenst candidates the Regratur may at the same coun exciudo the aforesaid wo or more cardidates lowest on the perll:

Provided that, the axhusion of these candiates shall wot reduee the number of ocrmaing candidates, below ite number of vacancies remainire to be filled.
15) When two or mese candidates cach have tze same nomber of votes and iowest on Se yoll, the candidates witk the fowest number of wotes at the first count at whot the cind dates in question have an ureotal number of voles sholl be exciuded and when the nomber of votes crodited to theso candidates are ondal ati counts, the Rogishor shat A aw lots and the candidate in whone name lot is drawn would stand excludea.
16) Upon the exclusion of any candidates, the Registray, save as heremafter provided, shal examine all the papers credited to that candidate, shali,--
(a) sont the transierable papors into sub-rareots according to the noxt availabie preforence recorded thercon for continuing candidates;
(b) transfer each suib parcel to tho candidate for whom that proforence is recorded; ind
(c) Set aside as a separato sub-parcel the nom-trarsferable papers.
(17) If at the end of any count, the mamber of ciected cardidates is equal to the whater of vacancies to bo inled, no frumor transfer of votos whall be made.

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(18) If on the exclusion of a sandidate or candidates, the number of the then continaing ardidates is equal to the number of vacancios unfilled, the continuing candidates shat! thereon be elected and no further transfer of votes shall be made.
(19) The order of priority of election of elected candidates shall be the order in which they are severaily clected. If, at the end of any count two or more candidates are ciected, tive order of priority shall be according to the number of votes credited to such candidates engming with the greatest. When the number of votes credited to two or more candidatess te equal or wher the candidates are elected unopposed, the order of priority of clection shall be in alphabetica. order.
(20) Whenever any transfer is made, each sub-parcel of paper transfored shal! bo flaced on the top of the parcei, if ady, of papers of the caindidate, to whom the transice is nacie and that candidato shall be credited with a number of votes equal to the number of papers transferrod to him.
(21) Non-transferabte papers, except such as ir the transfes of a surphis may be reguired for the duota or the ofected candidates, shall be set, aside as a separate parce Loocther with any parce? of noa-transferabio papers already sct aside.
(22) On the transfer of the surplus of an elected candidate, all papers not transiorres to continuing candidates ard not set, aside as provided in the preceding clatise, shall be placed together in one parcel as the quota of the elected canditiate and the parcel shail bo marked with the name of the elected candidate.

## 16. Result of Scrutiny and Counting--

(1) After the scrutiny and counting is completed, the result thereof shall be reported forthwith to the Vice-Chanceriox by the Registrar.
(2) On the result of the dection being reported as aforesaid, the resuit of the coumbing showing for each candidate, the number of first votes obtained and the successive additions, on subiractions from the mumber till the candidate was excluded or elected, shall be declared by the Registrar. Inmediately afer the final result is prepared, the voting papers shall be seated in a packet with the seal of one or more of the scrutinizers and then handed over to the Registray for safo custody tintil the destruction of the vowing papers.

## 17. Appeal. ...

(1) No demand of recounting shail be entertained after the fincil rounds are over. The candidate or the representative of the candidate may raise objection the end of a particular coint, if he desircs. He cannot raise any objection if the process of counting is entered into the next round.
(2) An Appeal against the result of the election shall be prefered to the Vice-Chancolloi whin thirty days from the date of declaration of the result.
(3) The voting papers and all other papers or records relating io election shall be dubroyed after six months from the date of declaration of the eloction rosult or in the owont of an appeal being preferred against the result to the Vice-Chancoltor, after thity days from the date of receipt of the Vice Chancellor's order, whichever is later.
