SYLLABUS

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN RETAIL MANAGEMENT (Under Career Oriented Programme of U.G.C., New Delhi)

THEORY – (10 Credits and 150 Hrs)

Unit-I: (2 Credits, 30 Hrs)

Retail sourcing overview – Introduction, Retail environment, functions of retailer, Retail sourcing – Types & Trends, Store types, organized retail, retail formats, malls.

Unit-II (2 Credits, 30 Hrs)

Organisation Structure –Single own shop, Super Market, Chain Store, Retail work culture, Common terms in retails, Visual Merchandising, Store Management.

Unit-III (2 Credits, 30 Hrs)

Store design objectives and layout, product knowledge, equipment handling, key store operation – preopening activities, post closing activities, staff entry procedures, staff exit procedure, staff scheduling, customer service desk, cashier activities, supply chain management.

Unit-IV (2 Credits, 30 Hrs)

Retail selling process – types of selling, customer contact skill, effective customer contact, types of customer, characteristics of a professional sales person, various customer services, handling complaints, Communication and customer handling, Grooming, Interviews Skills, Safety and Crises management recruitment and selection.

Unit-V (2 Credits, 30 Hrs)

Stock and inventory management, Buffer stock, Safety stock, Material Handling in Store, Mall Management, Factor influencing mall establishment.

PRACTICAL WORK: (Select any Five) (10 Credits and 150 Hrs)

- 1) Visit and Make hierarchy chart of Category management of a fashion and lifestyle retailer.
- 2) Identification of Best practices in buying in various retailers.
- 3) Statistical Analysis of consumer behavior for a retailer in Amravati.
- 4) Prepare questionnaire and analyze results for ten customer's vis-à-vis shopping patterns.
- 5) Identify the application of consumer behavior in retailing.
- 6) Study of various methods of advertising used by retailers in and around Amravati.
- 7) Identify factors influencing pricing strategy of four local products in Amravati City.
- 8) Understand the supply chain management in retailers in and around Amravati City.
