#### **REGULATION NO. 3/2022**

#### Subject: - Awarding to the Ideal Student (Male & Female) Regulation-2022

Whereas the Board of Students' Development vide item No.42 dated 27.10.2020 has decided to award as Ideal Student (One Male & One Female) of the affiliated colleges including University Teaching Department admitted thereat in an academic session for who prosecute the regular course of studies from academic session 2022-2023, in order to generate healthy competition among the talented students and inspire them to show brilliant performance in various academic and extracurricular activities. For acknowledging their accomplishments in public life and further encouraging them to achieve excellence of higher order at various stages of his/her academic career.

#### And

Whereas the Board has appointed a Committee to recommend a scheme and the Committee in its meeting held on 02.08.2021 has submitted the scheme which has been approved by the Board vide item No.48 in the meeting held on 27.10.2021.

#### And

Whereas the matter is to be regulated by regulation and as per Section 75 of the Act. The Board of Deans has power to prepare the Regulation.

#### And

Whereas the matter is of non-academic nature, fall u/s 75 (1) (f) of the Act and the Board of Deans recommends to the Management Council for approval.

Accordingly, the Management Council is pleased to make the following Regulation.

- 1. This Regulation shall be called "Awarding the Ideal Student (Male & Female) Regulation 2022"
- 2. This Regulation shall came into force from the academic session 2022-2023.
- 3. In this Regulation unless the context otherwise requires ---
  - i) "Act" means " Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016".
  - ii) "Board" means "Board of Students' Development U/s 56 of the Act.
  - iii) "Student" means "A student (Male & Female) admitted to a regular course of studies in an affiliated college or University Teaching Department".
  - iv) "University" means "Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University".
- 4.The scheme, norms and its modus-operandi, nature of award, application format, criteria, activities, award of marks for award, procedure etc. is appended as Annexure I to this Regulation.

# SANT GADGE BABA AMRAVATI UNIVERSITY THE IDEAL STUDENT AWARD (MALE AND FEMALE)

#### 1. Objective:

The aim of introducing SGBAU's The Ideal Student Award (Male and Female) is to generate healthy competition among the talented students and inspire them to show brilliant performance in various academic and extracurricular activities. For acknowledging their accomplishments in public life and further encouraging them to achieve excellence of higher order at various stages of his/her academic career.

#### 2. Awards:

Every year the university shall select and declare the one university student (male and female) award ceremoniously. The awardees shall be awarded cash amount of Rs. 15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen thousand) with memento and certificate by the university.

#### 3. Sub Committee:

Applications received in prescribed format and within the stipulated date shall be scrutinised and placed before a sub-committee consisting of the following members:

1.	One member from the Board of Students' Development	Chairman
	nominated by the Chairman of the Board	
2.	Three teachers connected to college who have expertise	Member
	in various activities	
3.	President/Secretary of the University Students' Council	Member
4.	Director, Students' Development	Member
		Secretary

- 1. The University shall invite applications for the SGBAU's The Ideal Student Award (Male and Female) for the academic year on or before 31<sup>th</sup> August.
- 2. The recommendations of the sub-committee in respect of the SGBAU's The Ideal Student Award (Male and Female) to be awarded in the academic year shall be placed before the Chairman of the Board of Students' Development every year on or before 10<sup>th</sup> September.
- 3. The University declare the award of scholarships every year on or before 20<sup>th</sup> September.
- 4. The office of the Director of Students' Development shall inform the recipient of the awards on his permanent postal address and to the Principal/ Head of Department / Institution where he is studying.
- 5. The awardees shall be felicitated at the hands of the guest invited for the program conducted by Board of Students' Development as per the availability of guest and schedule of other programs.
- 6. Transgender students can apply in one of the above categories.

#### 4. Criteria of the awards:

The norms for selecting the SGBAU's The Ideal Student Award (Male and Female) section shall be as follows:

#### Section: A

#### **Educational Background**

Students securing minimum 60% marks or 6 CGPA/SGPA (not rounded) shall be eligible to submit the proposal for SGBAU's The Ideal Student Award (Male and Female). Students of Graduate or Post Graduate or Diploma course may submit proposal considering their previous academic year exam results. Annual pattern students submit final exam marks and Semester pattern students add both the odd and even semester marks of the previous year examination.

#### **Section: B**

Students acquire marks from the below mentioned 25 criteria. Each criterion shall be of maximum 50 marks with equal sub points 10 marks each. Students shall earn maximum 10 marks for sub points of each criterion and have maximum of 50 marks for each criteria. Total 1250 for 25 Criteria

#### 5. Procedure for Application:

- An application for award shall be made in the prescribed form Appendix "A" through proper channel. The application shall be made in single copy and send directly to the office of Students' Development. Duplicate proposal copy be retained by him for the College / Department / Institution's record.
- Only the certificates of the previous academic year shall be taken into consideration for deciding the award. Certificates copy duly attested by the Principal/Students' Development Officer of the College.
- 3. One attested copy of each certificate regarding his/her achievements in various Activities in the previous academic year.
- 4. Proposal copy shall be proper indexing with page number and with proper binding (staple/spiral/general binding)
- 5. Board of Students' Development can change criterion as per need and demand of the time by following proper procedure.
- 6. Student should not show same activity in different criterion.
- 7. In case of equal marks, the following procedure shall be adopted for deciding inters merit.
  - a. An applicant with higher total marks at the previous qualifying examination will be given preference. If the still persists, then;
  - b. A younger applicant will be given preference over an elder applicant.
  - c. If the still tie persists, then deciding the award shall be resolved unanimously by the committee in light of the present other rules and regulations.
- 8. One copy of a recent passport size photograph (to be pasted on the application form in the space provided for it) attested by the Principal Students' Development Officer.
- 9. One attested copy of date of birth (Board Certificate/Transfer Certificate/any other document where the date of birth mentioned).
- 10. Any application received after the prescribed date shall not be considered.
- 11. Incorrect entry / entries in the application form or wrong declaration in respect of Activities etc. Scrutiny committee /sub-committee would make the proposal cancel for the award.
