## Ordinance No. 1 of 2021

### **An Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher class) and getting Distinction in the subject and Condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties, (Amendment ) Ordinance, 2021**

Whereas, it is expedient to amend the Ordinance in respect of "An Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher class) and getting Distinction in the subject and Condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties, Ordinance No. 18/2001, Hereinafter referred to as main Ordinance for the purpose hereinafter appearing, The Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance.

- 1) This Ordinance may be called , An Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher class) and getting Distinction in the subject and Condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021.
- 2) This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its passing by the Management Council.
- 3) In the main Ordinance, the following new rule as "Rule-I (a)" be added after 3<sup>rd</sup> proviso, i.e. above "Notes:-

Rule-I (a) : The Facilities, exemption and concession for differently abled and Physically disabled examinee of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University shall be provided 3% grace marks of the total marks (aggregate) in one subject for "Head passing written examination, oral/viva, practical, research project etc." or by divisions **of the marks to all the passing head as given below. :**

- 4) **First** add marks to the **passing heads** with least or minimum marks obtained, and thereafter, second. Third, fourth and so on 3% **exhasion of** marks.
- 5) If needed, the marks as per the earlier ordinances 1/1985 and 18/2001 as mentioned in Rule (I) above shall be awarded to the disabled candidates.

## Ordinance No. 2 of 2021

### Examination in General (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021

Where as it is expedient to amend the **Ordinance No.06** in respect of Examinations in General for the purpose hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is here by pleased to make the following Ordinance.

1. This Ordinance may be called "Examination in General (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021".
2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its passing by the Management Council.
3. **The para 34 (ii) of the Original Ordinance No.6 be substituted as under :**  
**"These candidates will be given same college or nearer college to his/her house as the examination centre".**
4. In the Original Ordinance No.6, para 34, clause (iii), **be substituted as under.**
  - iii) The candidate will have to submit the certificate to the effect and the recommendation of the Principal/Heads of the concerned College/Department.
  - iv) The Principal of the respective affiliated college should prepare "Disabled friends group" of minimum 10 **friends. Disabled students** will select one of them who is willing to act as a writer for him/her. **He/She** can also select writer of his/her own choice. **The selected writer must not belong to the same or higher Teel of studies to which the examinee is appearing.**
  - v) Answer Books will be stamped as PWD and the necessary **instruction to be given at the time of evaluation.**
  - vi) Differently able students of all categories will be given additional 20 minutes per hour besides the stipulated time span.
  - vii) Marks should not be deducted for any types of grammatical or technical mistakes as the time of evaluation.
  - viii) **Attendance in the college** is not mandatory for appearing in the university examinations.
  - ix) All other facilities are applicable as per this Ordinance and guidelines given in the Maharashtra Government Resolution miscellaneous No.2016 No.302 dated 4<sup>th</sup> of March, 2017.
