**Appointment/Nomination of eminent person as Research Professor in the University,
Regulation 2022**

Whereas it is expedient to make the Regulation in respect of Appointment/Nomination of eminent person as Research Professor in the University for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to approve the following Regulation.

1. This Regulation may be called “Appointment/Nomination of eminent person as Research Professor Regulation, 2022”
2. This Regulation shall come into force from the date of its approval by the Management Council.
3. Acclaimed Academicians/Researchers with the University, who have been professionally active and have a record of high quality research and scholarly outputs and scholarly impact in a sustained manner in their career, would be valuable to meet higher quality bench marks in teaching and research. It not only provides a channel for utilization of the services of highly qualified and capable individuals who are in good health and have many more productive years left, but also to some extent helps in meeting the shortage of such persons in the academic and research affairs of the University shall be eligible to be appointed /nominated under this scheme.
4. Eminent and Competent persons shall be engaged by the University under this Research Professor scheme. Such senior academicians will supplement teaching/research and will collaborate with the faculty of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University to stimulate activities for quality research at Master and Ph.D. levels and productivity of quality and impactful scholarly outputs besides playing mentoring and inspirational roles for researchers.
5. Objectives of this Scheme are as under;
 - a. To provide recognition to a Professorial staff of the University department who has made contributions in high quality research and impactful scholarly outputs
 - b. To enable him/ her to continue to contribute to the subject of his/her choice after superannuation upto the age of 70 years.
 - c. To increase productivity of high quality research and impactful scholarly outputs of the University.
 - d. To play a research mentorship/supervisory role for young researchers, PhD and PG students
6. TERMS & CONDITIONS for appointment/nomination of Eminent Person as Research Professor
 - A) Eligibility Criteria:
 - i) Any member of the professorial staff who has served any recognized University in the country for at least ten years and retired from the level of Senior Professor/ Professor of the University department.
 - ii) All time followed good academic/research practices in research and research publications, thesis and other scholarly outputs, patents, consultancies, etc. and also adhered to the highest civic and ethical standards.
 - iii) The nominee/applicant should be a scholar of nationally and internationally recognized eminence and her/his contribution should have made a difference/impact to the discipline and/or to the society. The difference to the discipline/society could be judged in terms of formulation of new concepts/ paradigms/ hypotheses/ innovations by peer group academics and should be in evidence through primary research publications and other form of scholarly output/patent and scholarly impact.

iv) Minimum 200 APII points in which at least 100 APII points must be from the APII's of 4 or more points as given in the TABLE-I of the APPENDIX, which is appended with this Regulation respectively.

v) At least 50 post PhD research publications included in the Nature Index or Book Citation Index (BKCI) or the Science Citation Index-Expanded (SCIE) or the Social Science Citation Index (SSCI) or the Arts & Humanities Citation Index (A&HCI) and in which at least 10 publications must have been published during the last 5 years.

7) Honorarium:

Honorarium of Rs. 35,000/-p.m. (consolidated). In addition contingency grant (non-lapsable) of Rs. 50,000/- p.a. towards secretarial assistance, travel within the country connected with the research project, stationery, postage, consumables, books and journals and equipment. However, books, journals and equipment etc. procured out of the contingency grant will be the property of the university. The expenditure would be accounted for audit by the university department concerned like any other departmental expenditure.

8) Tenure:

The Research Professor can be appointed for an initial period of three years. After review/assessment of their work, they can be continued for two more years. After completion of five years term, a comprehensive report highlighting academic achievements may be subjected to peer review by three referees for a possible further extension of 3+2 years. In no case they will be continued beyond 70 years of age.

9) Expectations:

i) The "Research Professor" will engage himself/herself in teaching (maximum 4 lectures per week) and research in the Department. However, he/she will not be assigned any administrative work of the Department/University.

ii) Nature of expected work : The selected person -

- a) will be associated with a Department of the University;
- b) shall teach one course per semester in the University department;
- c) shall play advisory role for curriculum enrichment
- d) will develop National and International research collaborations and networking;
- e) will act as mentor/supervisor of Post-Graduate, Doctoral, Post-Doctoral, and Faculty members of the department;
- f) will submit research proposals to various funding agencies for support along with a co-investigator from the University department
- g) should contribute profoundly to the research activities in the University by way of patents, Research publications /reviews/ monographs/ books indexed in the Nature Index /BKCI /SCIE / SSCI/ A&HCI.

10) Cancellation of Appointment:

The appointment may be cancelled in case of ;

- a) Misconduct,
- b) Deviation from good academic research practices,
- c) Ineligibility of the candidate if noticed later.

11) Miscellaneous:

i) The Research Professor will agree to observe the University's policies in relation to confidential information and data protection, protect the reputation of the University and conduct his or herself in manner consistent with the University's published policies and procedures. This includes the University's policy in respect of intellectual property ownership; including copyright and other related matters, as may be in force and as modified from time to time by the University.

- ii) In general the working place of the Research Professor will be the particular University department to which he/she was retired. However, if his/her work is multi-disciplinary/interdisciplinary in nature, he may choose any one department as place of work with the approval of Vice Chancellor.
- iii) The Research Professor shall not undertake any teaching or research in another institution during the period of tenure at the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University. The Head of Department, in which he/she is attached, shall provide office space and other academic support/facilities, as feasible.
- iv) Foreign visit in connection with the approved research work of the awardee will be limited to twice in a year with the prior approval/no-objection of the University. However, there shall be no limit for short term (upto one week) foreign visit to participate/ present the research in conferences/ seminar/ symposia/ workshops/ meetings with prior approval of the University. This will be further subject to no financial liability on the part of University.
- v) The Research Professor shall be entitled for 30 days /year leave with honorarium. All kinds of leaves shall be approved at the level of the University.
