Rule No. 4. of 2012

University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund Rules, 2012

Whereas it is expedient to make rules for university Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund, the Management Council is hereby pleased to approve the following rules.

1. These rules may be called "University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare fund, Rules, 2012"
2. These rules shall come into force with effect from date of its date approval by the management council.
3. **Creation of Fund :**
University shall create a fund called "University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare fund" out of the following receipts :
 - (a) Deduction of Rs. 200/- annually from the salary payable to university non-teaching employees for the month of December of every calendar year.
 - (b) Deduction of 5% of the net amount from overtime Allowances payable to university non-teaching employees, and 2% of the substitute allowance payable to the university non-teaching employees.
 - (c) Donations, if any, received from the Government, University, Colleges, and from other sources towards this fund;
 - (d) Interest investments made from out of this fund.
4. **Objects :**
The fund shall be utilized for giving financial assistance to the university non-teaching employees and their dependents. The term "University Non-Teaching Employee" includes all employees appointed substantively, excluding teachers and other academic staff.
5. **Mode of Financial Assistance :**
The financial assistance will be made either by way of Lone with or without interest or as an outright grant as provided in para 8 and 12 respectively.
6. **Administration of the fund :**
 - (i) The Fund shall be administrated by a Committee called "University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund Committee" consisting of the following :-
 1. Vice -Chancellor, Ex- officio Chairman,
 2. One person nominated by the Management Council from amongst its members.
 3. A person who is nominated by the Vice- Chancellor from amongst the non-teaching employees on the Senate,
 4. President of university non-teaching employees union,
 5. President of university employees co-operative society,
 6. Registrar of the university, who shall act as a Ex-officio Treasurer of this fund.
 7. Finance & Accounts officer of the university shall be the member Secretary.
 - (ii) The person shall cease to be a member of this committee as soon as he/ she ceases to be a member of the authority/ office.
 - (iii) No T. A. And D. A. or Local Conveyance Allowance shall be payable to the members . (Outstation member of the committee will be paid T. A. by bus only and D. A. as per rules from this fund.)
 - (iv) The quorum of the committee will be of 5. The Committee will meet as often as desired by the Chairman but it must meet at least once in a year.
 - (v) In case of emergency and when it is not expedient to call the meeting of the committee, the Chairman may sanction loans or out-right grants upto a limit as prescribed in para 8 and 12 and report to the committee at its next meeting
7. **Operation of the Fund :**
 - (i) For all money recived, regular printed computerised money receipts shall be issued.
 - (ii) Separate Saving Bank Account shall be opened in one of the nationalised banks in the name of "Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare fund" to which all amounts received shall be credited on the next working day. The Saving Bank Account shall be operated jointly by Secretary and Treasurer.

- (iii) Separate Account Books shall be maintained and at the close of each year, final accounts shall be prepared and got audited from university auditors. The audited accounts together with the audit report shall be submitted to the Management Council of the university as well as the senate through the University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund Committee. The audited accounts shall be printed separately in the Annual Financial Budget of the University.

8. Grant of Loans.

- (i) Any non-teaching employee of the university in need of a loan from this fund shall submit his application through proper channel to the chairman in the form prescribed for the purpose. The application for loan from the fund should be accompanied by the irrevocable authority authorizing the employer to deduct from the applicant's salary and other payments due, the installments of the loan and interest thereon for payment towards the 'University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund.
- (ii) No fresh loan shall be sanctioned unless the previous loan, if granted, is recovered in full with interest.
- (iii) The maximum loan that can be sanctioned to a non-teaching employee of the university shall be Rs. 25,000/- the recovery of loan and interest shall be made in not more than 40 equal monthly installments from the salary of the month next to that of disbursement of loan. As soon as loanee ceases to be a non-teaching employee of university shall be liable to refund the entire balance of loan immediately.
- (iv) The applicant who is permanent in service should have put in atleast 2 years continuous service as non-teaching employee of the university on the date of application for loan.
- (v) The applicant for loan should provide a surety by another non-teaching employee of the university who is permanent in service and is not likely to retire from the service within 4 years from the date of application for loan.
- (vi) The applicant shall specify in his application for loan the names and addresses of his successors, their ages, relations with the applicant and who, from amongst them, are dependents. Similarly, the applicant shall indicate his total monthly emoluments and full particulars of deduction there from and the net salary he is drawing. Besides, he will also state whether he has obtained loans from other sources like Banks, Co-operative Society etc. and what are the monthly installments due to be paid in respect of each such loan.
- (vii) The university non-teaching employee applying for loan and his surety shall have to execute the "Bond" on stamp paper in the prescribed form. This Bond shall be counter-signed by the Registrar. The applicant shall submit this Bond to the university on receipt of intimation that the loan is sanctioned to him.
- (viii) The Registrar shall certify that the details given in the application are verified and found correct and that the loan, if sanctioned, will be recovered from the applicant's salary regularly from his salary bill and the deduction so made shall be refunded to the university promptly.
- (ix) In the event of death/ retirement of loanee before repayment of loan and interest thereon in full, the amount alongwith the interest shall be recovered from the dues payable to the loanee after his death and retirement. In the event of non recovery from the dues, the dependents and the surety shall be liable to pay the balance of loan and interest. The Registrar shall immediately start recovery of the loan and interest thereon from the salary of the surety, if the dependents fails to remaining balance of loan and interest.

9. Rate of Interest on Loan :

The rate of interest on loans shall be decided by the University Non-Teaching Employees' Welfare Fund Committee from time to time. Whenever, the rate of interest is changed, the change shall be effective from the beginning of the next

financial year. The rate of interest whenever changed, shall be circulated to all non-teaching employee well in time. Normally, the rate of interest so fixed shall not exceed the rate fixed for grant of loan/advance to the non-teaching employees from the provident fund.

10. **Purpose of Lone :**

Loan may be paid to an individual under the following circumstances :-

- (i) In the event accident or serious illness to himself, his wife, dependent children and dependent parents.
- (ii) For any other reason which the 'University Non-Teaching Employee' Welfare Fund Committee deems fit.

11. **Disbursement of Lone :**

Actual disbursement of lone may take place from the 2nd next financial year Coming after the approval of these Rules.

12. **Out-right Grant :**

In the event of death of the University Non-Teaching Employee before retirement, an outright grant of Rs. 10,000/- shall be paid to his wife/her husband or in her/his absence to the legal heirs of the deceased.

For claiming this ex-gratia payment of Rs. 10,000/- the Registrar shall infrom in Wriring to the chairman of the 'Non-Teaching Employee' Welfare Fund Committee about the death of the said employee. He will also infrom the name of deceased employee's wife/husband or in her/his absence the legal heirs in whose favour the payment should made. On receipt of such intimation the payment shall be made immediately and the matter shall be reported to committee at its next meeting.

Subject : Examinations leading to the Post Graduate Diploma in Import and Export Management (Semester Pattern) (One Year Course) in the faculty of Commerce.

Whereas, the Govt. of Maharashtra Ministry of Higher and Technical Education Dept. Mumbai has granted the permission to start the P.G.Diploma course in Import and Export Management, in the affiliated colleges of the University vide its G.R. No. एनजीसी-२००९/(१७१/०९) मशि-४, दिनांक १४ जुलै, २००९

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council has resolved to accept the Scheme of Examination, Eligibility criteria and other detail provisions for P.G.Diploma course in Import and Export Management, in its meeting held on 13/1/2012, vide item No. 14(1) B) R-2.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council has resolved to accept the syllabi for P.G.Diploma course in Import and Export Management to be implemented from the academic session 2012-13.

AND

Whereas, the Scheme of Examination, Eligibility criteria and Syllabi is to be made available for the said course from the academic session 2012-13.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council has resolved to refer the scheme of examination to the Ordinance Committee for framing the Ordinance for the said P.G.Diploma course.

AND

Whereas, the admissions for the P.G. Diploma in Import and Export Management in the faculty of Commerce are to be made in the Academic Session 2012-13

AND

Whereas, Examination leading to the P.G. Diploma in Import and Export Management in the faculty of Commerce are to be conducted in Winter-2012.

AND

Whereas, the matter of Scheme of Examination, Eligibility criteria and other detail provisions is required to be regulated by an Ordinance, and making Ordinance is time consuming process.

Now, therefore I, Dr. M.K.Khedkar, Vice-Chancellor, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, do hereby direct as under-

1. This Direction may be called, "Examinations leading to the P.G.Diploma in Import and Export Management (Semester Pattern) (One Year Course) in the faculty of Commerce, Direction, 2012.
2. This direction shall come into force from the academic session 2012-13.
3. Following shall be the Examinations leading to the –
 - i) Post Graduate Diploma in Import and Export Management, Semester-I Examination..
 - ii) Post Graduate Diploma in Import and Export Management, Semester-II Examination.
4. Duration of each of the above semester shall be six months with an examination at the end of each semester.
5. i) The examinations specified in paragraph 3 shall be held twice a year at such places and on such dates as may be appointed by the Board of Examinations.
 - ii) Main examination of Semester-I shall be held in Winter and supplementary Examination in Summer.
 - iii) Main examination of Semester-II shall be held in Summer and supplementary Examination in Winter.
6. Subject to his/her compliance with the provision of this Direction and of other Ordinances in force from time to time the following candidates shall be eligible for admission to Post Graduate Diploma in Import and Export Management (Semester Pattern) (One Year Course) Examinations namely- Bachelor's degree of this University in any faculty or of any other Statutory University whose Degree is recognized as equivalent thereto by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
7. Subject to his/her compliance with the provisions of this Direction and of other Ordinance (pertaining to examination in general) in force from time to time, the applicant for admission to examination at the end of course of study of a particular semester shall be eligible to appear at it, if he/she satisfied the conditions in the table and the provision thereunder :-

8. Without prejudice to the other provisions of Ordinance No.6 relating to the examinations in general, the provisions of paragraphs 5,8,10,27 and 32 of the said ordinance shall apply to every collegiate candidates.
9. The medium of instruction and examination for the course shall be English only and the scope of the subjects shall be as indicated in the syllabus.
10. The fees for the examinations shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.
11. An applicant for the examination prosecuting a regular course of study to the P.G.Diploma course shall not seek admission to any other academic courses in this or any other University.
12. The Sessional/Internal marks shall be awarded by the Head of the College/Department in consultation with the teachers as per the scheme provided under the scheme of examinations of the respective course.
13. The scope of papers and detail scheme of examinations and teaching workload for theory and Project shall be as indicated in Appendix-A.
14. An examinees who will unsuccessful at the examinations shall be eligible for admission to the examinations on payment of a fresh fee prescribed for the examinations together with an ex-student fee shall be as per Ordinance No.12, and on compliance with the conditions of the Ordinance in force from time to time.
15. An examinee who has failed at the Sessional /Project examinations only shall be required to register himself afresh for doing the Sessional/Project work again in the College/Department concerned in the subject or subjects in which he so failed, on payment of a fresh examination fee shall be as per Ordinance No.12. The Head of the Department/College, shall, on being satisfied about the completion of the Sessional/Project of such a candidate, send the fresh Sessional/Project marks to the University and these fresh Sessional/Project marks shall be taken into consideration for computing his result at the examination.
16. Successful examinees obtaining 60% or more marks in the aggregate at the examination shall be placed in the First Division and those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 50% in the second division.
17. The provisions of Ordinance No.18 of 2001 shall be applicable to the examinees of this course.
18. No persons shall be admitted to this examinations, if he has already passed the same examination or an equivalent examination of any other Statutory University.
19. The names of examinees passing the examination as a whole in the minimum prescribed period and obtaining the prescribed number of places in the First or Second Division shall be arranged in Order of Merit as provided in the Examinations in General Ordinance No.6.
Provided that the Merit lists only be published for Summer Examination.
20. A successful examinee shall receive a P.G.Diploma in the prescribed form, signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

- 1) This Direction may be called " Examinations leading to the Post - Graduate Diploma in (i) Mechatronics, (ii) Biomedical Electronics, and (iii) Computer Maintenance (Semester Pattern-One Year (Full Time) P.G.Diploma Course] in the faculty of Science, Directions, 2012".
- 2) This Direction shall come into force from the date of its issuance.
- 3) Following shall be the Examinations leading to the Post - Graduate Diploma in-
 - (i) Mechatronics/Biomedical Electronics/Computer Maintenance, Semester-I Examination.
 - (ii) Mechatronics/Biomedical Electronics/Computer Maintenance, Semester-II Examination.
- 4) Duration of each of the above semester shall be six months with an examination at the end of each semester.
- 5) (i) The examinations specified in paragraph 3 above shall be held twice a year at such places and on such dates as may be appointed by the Board of Examinations.
 - (ii) Main Examination of Semester-I shall be held in Winter and Supplementary Examination in Summer.
 - (iii) Main Examination of Semester-II shall be held in Summer and Supplementary Examination in Winter.
- 6) Subject to his/her compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance and of other Ordinances in force from time to time, the following candidates shall be eligible for admission to the Post-Graduate Diploma in-
 - (i) **Mechatronics**
 - a) A person who has passed B.Sc. examination with Electronics or Computer Science of this University or any other statutory University recognized equivalent by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
 - OR
 - b) A person who has passed Bachelor of Engineering (Electronics and Power System/Industrial Electronics/Mechanical Engineering) Degree of this University or any other statutory University recognized equivalent by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
 - (ii) **Biomedical Electronics**
 - a) A person who has passed B.Sc. examination with Electronics or Physics of this University or any other statutory University recognized equivalent by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University....

OR

- b) A person who has passed Bachelor of Engineering (Electronics Discipline) Degree of this University or any other statutory University recognized equivalent by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.

(iii) Computer Maintenance

- a) A person who has passed B.Sc. examination with Mathematic/Physics/ Electronics / Computer Science / Information Technology / Computer Application (Regular/Vocational)/Computer Maintenance of this University or any other statutory University recognized equivalent by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.

OR

- b) A person who has passed Bachelor of Computer Application Degree of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati

- 7) Subject to his/her compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance and of other Ordinances (Pertaining to examination in General) in force from time to time, the applicant for admission to examination at the end of the course of study of a particular Semester shall be eligible to appear at it, if: (i) he/she satisfied the conditions in the table and the provisions thereunder :-

- 10) An examinee who is successful at Semester-I, Semester-II examinations under this Ordinance and who has obtained 75% or more marks in aggregate of Semester-I, Semester-II Examinations shall be placed in the First Division with Distinction, those obtaining 60% or more but less than 75% shall be placed in the First Division and all other successful examinees shall be placed in the Second Division.
- 11) (i) Scope of the subjects shall be as indicated in the syllabus.
 (ii) Medium of instruction and examination shall be English.
- 12) Provision of Ordinance No.18 of 2001 relating to an Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in a head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher Class) and getting distinction in the subject and condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute No.18 and of Ordinance No.10 relating to Providing for Exemptions and Compartments shall apply to the examination under this Ordinance.
- 13) An examinee who does not pass or who fails to present himself/herself for the examination shall be eligible for readmission to the same examination on payment of fresh fees and such other fees as may be prescribed.

Whereas, the matter for changing the eligibility table and adding new provision is required to be regulated by an Ordinance, and making amendment in respective Ordinance is time consuming process.

Whereas the revised eligibility table regarding admission in next higher class, and medium for instructions and examinations for practical of all the Computer papers in the M.Com. course are to be made applicable from the academic session 2012-2013.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. M.K. Khedkar, Vice-Chancellor, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under sub section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, do hereby direct as under-

- 1) This Direction may be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of (वाणिज्य पारंगत) Master of Commerce (Bi-annual pattern) (Two Year Course) Direction 2012".
- 2) This direction shall come into force from the date of its issuance.
- 3) The present Eligibility Table appearing under Para 7 of Ordinance No. 19 of 2003 be substituted by the following table-

3. i) In the third line of para-4 of Direction No. 22/2011, the word 'annually' appears before the words 'at such' and after the word 'held' be substituted by the words 'at the end of each Semesters'.
ii) In para-7 of said Direction, the lines, 'The student who have passed one yearin all 4 semester' be substituted by the following sentence.

"The student who have passed one year Post-Degree course in Journalism &/or Mass Communication e.g. B.M.C., B.J. only from Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University will be eligible to take admission in Semester-III of M.J.M.C.. The division will be awarded on the basis of combined score in B.M.C., B.J. degree and IIIrd & IVth semester of M.J.M.C. combined. However, for regular M.J.M.C. students, combined score of all four semesters will be the basis of award of division".
