Subject :- Examination leading to the Post Graduate Diploma in Performing Folk Arts (One Year) course in the Faculty of Inter-Disciplinary Studies

Whereas, the post Graduate Diploma in Performing Folk Art has approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra vide its order No.NGC-2012/(143/12)MC-4 , dated 2 July, 2012 to the Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Mahavidyalaya, Akoli, Sainagar, Amravati. from the Academic Session 2012-2013.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council has approved the scheme of examination for above said course in its meeting held on 18.4.2013 vide Item No. 44 from the Academic Session 2017-2018.

AND

Whereas. the scheme of examination and other details provision for admission to the said course are to be regularized by the Ordinance and making of an Ordinance may likely to take some time.

AND

Whereas, the scheme of examination and syllabi of course are to be implemented from the academic session 2018-2019 .

Now, therefore, I Dr.Murlidhar Chandekar, Vice-Chancellor of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, in exercise of powers vested upon me under sub-section (8) of section (12) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 , do hereby direct as under :

- 1) This direction may be called "Examination leading to the Post Graduate Diploma in Performing Folk Art (One Year) course in the faculty of Inter-Disciplinary Studies, Direction 2018.
- 2) This Direction shall come into force from the session 2018- 2019
- 3) The duration of the Post Graduate Diploma in Performing Folk Art course shall be of one academic year.
- 4) The Examination leading to the Post Graduate Diploma in Performing Folk Art course shall be held annually at such places and on such dates as may be appointed by the Academic Council. The supplementary examination shall be held in winter.
- 5) Subject to his /her compliance with the provisions of this Direction and of other Ordinance (Pertaining to Examination) in force from time to time, the candidates for admission to the examination shall have been obtained a Bachelor's degree in any faculty of this University or of any other statutory University whose degree is recognised as equivalent thereto by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
- 6) The candidates may be admitted to this course in accordance with the rules of the University.
- 7) Without prejudice to the other provisions of Ordinance No.6 relating to Examination General, the provisions of paragraphs 5,8,10, 27 and 32 of the said Ordinance shall apply every collegiate candidate.
- 8) The fees of the examination shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time .
- 9) In order to gain credits of the examination, an examinee shall obtain not less than 40% marks in each of the theory papers and Practical.
- 10) The scope of the subjects for examination shall be as indicated in the syllabus.
- 11) The scheme of examination for the course shall be as provided under Appendix-A Table- I appended with this Direction, and the examinee shall be examined in the subjects as indicated in the scheme of examination.
- 12) Unsuccessful examinees at the above examination shall be eligible for admission to the next written and / or practical examination on payment of fresh fees prescribed for the examination together with an ex-student fee.
- 13) Provisions of Ordinance No.18 of 2001 in respect of an Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in a head of passing and improvement of division (Higher Class) and getting distinction in the subject and condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute No.18 , and of Ordinance No.10 relating to grant of exemptions and compartment shall be applicable to this course.

14) As soon possible after the examination, the Board of Examinations shall publish a list of successful examinees. The list of examinees successful at examination shall be arranged as per Yearly Grade Point Average. The names of the examinees passing in the said examination in the minimum prescribed period of arranged in order of merit as per provisions of Ordinance No.6.

15) The examinees successful at the examination of the above P.G.Diploma course shall be awarded Diploma in the prescribed form signed by the Vice-Chancellor, on payment of the prescribed fees.
