

Regulation No.7/2019

Modalities for undertaking academic collaboration programmes, research and advisory services with universities, institutions and organization etc. at Local, Regional, State, National and International Level.

Whereas it is expedient to frame the Regulation for formulating Modalities to undertake academic collaboration programmes, research and advisory services with universities, institutions and organization etc. at Local, Regional, State, National and International Level, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Regulation:

1. This Regulation may be called "Modalities for undertaking academic collaboration programmes, research and advisory services with universities, institutions and organization etc. at Local, Regional, State, National and International Level".
2. This Regulation shall come into force with effect from the date of its approval by the Management Council.
3. Definitions :
 - i. "University" means Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University established by Amravati University Act, 1983 (Maharashtra) (xxxvii) and as mentioned in the schedule Part-I of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016
 - ii. "Collaboration" means collaborative academic activity of the university or college or institution with other universities, academic institutions including local, regional, national or international institutions, research institutions and organizations in the field of agriculture, industry, trade and commerce, sports, social, cultural, science, technology and any other field.
 - iii. "Institution" means an academic institution of higher learning, not being a college, associated with and admitted to the privileges of the university;
 - iv. "University Department" means a department established and maintained by the University as prescribed by the Statutes.
 - v. "College" means a college affiliated to the university, situated in the university area or jurisdiction;
4. The document of academic collaboration shall encapsulate within the following structure of titles

 - ii. Background
 - iii. Definition of terms
 - iv. Aims and Objective of the Collaboration
 - v. Scope of the Collaboration
 - vi. Terms and conditions
 - vii. Legislative Context
 - viii. Joint Undertakings and Responsibilities
 - ix. Focal Points
 - x. Proposed Outcome/Deliverables
 - xi. Mutual Benefit
 - xii. Financial Implication
 - xiii. Beneficiary
 - xiv. Structure of Executive Committee
 - xv. Period
 - xvi. Review of amendments of the collaboration
 - xvii. IPR
 - xviii. Disclosure of Confidential information
 - xix. Force Majeure
 - xx. Arbitration/Jurisdiction
 - xxi. Limitations
 - xxii. Termination
5. The Vice-Chancellor shall make any alterations as per the requirement of the academic collaboration
6. The concerned section shall seek the opinion/remarks from Legal Officer before undertaking any academic collaboration.
7. If the aforementioned titles do not befit while undertaking academic collaboration with institutions abroad, the Vice-Chancellor shall take the decision in this regard.
